JOB TITLE: Politics Intern

JOB SUMMARY:

The intern will carry out numerous tasks, focusing on both the operational and research side of the organisation. The intern will be taking part in activities within the Operations Team, Digital Team and International Trade and Competition Unit (ITCU).

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Take on a significant project about the UK's relationship with the Customs Union and the post-Brexit regulatory environment
- Carry out several personal research projects in order to deepen the intern's knowledge of economics and the current British political debate

PLACEMENT STRUCTURE

Month 1: Focus on carrying out basic tasks, choosing a personal research topic and ensuring they are up to date on the basics of free market economics

Month 2-3: Intern will be deployed into more specific and challenging topics. The intern will be given a specific project and will be expected to carry out independent research, as well as having completed the first personal research project.

Month 4-5: The intern will be given a minor leadership role over a project that will require them to not only carry out research but also manage other interns to ensure the completion of the work within acceptable timeframes.

Month 6: By this stage the intern is expected to be acting quasi-independently on operations and research issues, writing a final personal research project which will link together their previous personal work.
